These unknowns may continue for the next few weeks as Oklahoma modifies its methods to contain any spread of the virus. As these decisions are made by government leaders, we will continue to update each of you on their impact in providing an education to your child.

Over the last week, our faculty have been working diligently to learn new mediums of communication and ways to engage your children. ## • How will assignments/activities be communicated?

- Each week you will receive an email on Sunday evening with the subject line reflecting: (Grade Level ) Digital Week 1/2/3/ etc.
- The supplement youtube videos will be labeled in order, so if you have a 2nd grade math lesson, you can search our channel for "2nd grade Math 1 (for first lesson), or 2nd Grade Math 2 (for second lesson). The description will include the date of the lesson so you know the order.
- O You will meet weekly for one hour with the faculty member in a live zoom meeting. The content and topics will be sent to you by the individual faculty member.
- How will grading be impacted? Pass/Fail grade options are available and help us adapt to the current circumstances. We can utilize these for the remainder of the final trimester if necessary but I am deferring to faculty to grade assignments during our online adventure. In middle school, this will be communicated with your child.
- Will we remain open to educate? Terra Verde will remain open to provide socially distant education throughout the COVID-19 event. Our plan is to be responsive, committed, and to communicate extensively with each of you to provide the best experience we can given the circumstances.

#### How long will this last?

We are currently planning two weeks of online offerings with an understanding that this global event may continue through April and May. Terra Verde's campus is closed until April 6th, 2020 at this time. Our plan is to tweak our offerings/expectations and to constantly explore better ways to engage our students. The faculty/staff will continue our weekly meetings and are in constant communication.

### • Parent expectations?

• We realize that many of you will still be going to work, or working from home. You do not need to replicate an 8 hour instructional day with your child. Our goal is provide them with content to entertain and engage in learning. We encourage you to take time to enjoy your child while working on a few of our assignments with them!
