



Oklahoma History Up Close and Personal

This two-week course will cover the essential standards required by the Oklahoma State Department of Education in order to receive high school credit upon completion. The course includes a combination of on campus instruction and field trip experiences to locations around the state that are pertinent to the curriculum. We are opening enrollment in the course to TVDS Alumni and outgoing 8th graders first. The class will be capped at 14 students due to the travel requirement and current pandemic.
